Resident Choreographer

Danielle Bilios has worked across the entertainment industry both creatively and as a performer and has established herself as a versatile Resident Choreographer with dance expertise across every genre.

Danielle graduated from Ed5 International Full Time Performing Arts Course in 2006 and quickly became one of Australia's most respected and in demand commercial dancers working alongside the country's leading choreographers. She has performed with many prominent international music artists in televised and live events including Taylor Swift at the 2012 *Aria Awards*, Ricky Martin for *The Voice Australia* and Kylie Minogue for the 2012 Formula 1 Grand Prix concert. Danielle has performed with countless national and international music artists including Tina Arena, Ricki Lee, Olivia Newton John, DJ Havana Brown, Jessica Mauboy, Macy Gray, Marcia Hines, Natalie Bassingthwaight and Sam Sparro for various special events and live concerts.

Danielle was a Resident Dancer on *X Factor Australia* and toured with the X Factor Live Concert in 2013. She has been Assistant Choreographer on *So You Think You Can Dance Australia* for several choreographers including creative directors, The Squared Division and was assistant to *TAP DOGS* choreographer Dein Perry for the NRL Centenary Opening Ceremony.

While maintaining a successful commercial dance career Danielle also moved into musical theatre initially as a performer, quickly becoming a dance captain and then moving into Resident Choreographer positions.

Danielle's diverse theatre credits show her versatility as a performing artist and include the Australia tour of *Matilda The Musical*, the Australian tour of *Wicked*, Handa Opera's *Carmen* on Sydney Harbour, *Le Grande Cirque*, *Fame the Musical* and *The Countdown Spectacular* concerts.

Resident Choreographer theatre credits include 2019/2020 Australian tour of *Billy Elliot* and the Australian revival tour of *MAMMA MIA!* Prior to this she worked on the Helpmann Award winning *Matilda The Musical*, originally as Dance Captain for the Australian tour and then as Resident Choreographer for the New Zealand season.
